Surveying Courses Worksheet Supplemental Application for Surveyor Registration in the State of Ohio

This form must be completed by applicants seeking eventual registration in Ohio as a Professional Surveyor who do not have a B.S. degree in surveying. Ohio Revised Code Section 4733.11 (B) allows an applicant with an EAC/ABET accredited B.S. degree in Civil Engineering (B.S.C.E.) to be eligible for eventual reistration as a Professional Surveyor if the applicant has completed 24 quarter hours (or 16 semester hours) of Board-approved surveying courses, including at least 8 quarter hours (or 6 semester hours) of courses in property surveying. The course category requirements are listed below. This form must be accompanied by original transcripts showing a B.S.C.E. degree and completion of the the courses listed hereon.
